This is the third year of the partnership between the City of Artesia and Cerritos Presbyterian Church to encourage and support students to pursue a vocational trade or higher education. This program provides Artesia residents with an opportunity to earn a scholarship that will assist each student in their pursuit of a vocation or higher education.
