Scheduled Sidewalk Maintenance for Districts 4 and 5 to Begin November 2nd

On November 2nd, the City will begin sidewalk maintenance and repair work for Districts 4 and 5 (all areas of the City south of 183rd Street) under the Sidewalk Assessment and Repair Program. In 2019, the City Council put this Program in place to ensure the safety and usability of Artesia's sidewalks far into the future.

Over the last year under the Program, the City's contractor, Precision Concrete Company, has addressed all large sidewalk lifts in the City, and will begin working to address the medium lifts this year. This marks the beginning of the City's regular cycle of maintenance for all City sidewalks, similar to the system the City uses for tree maintenance.

The City is looking forward to improving sidewalk safety and usability throughout Artesia and will continue looking for ways to beautify the community. If members of the community have any questions regarding the program, they may call (562) 865-6262.
